The Legislation Committee Chair Joan Howell and her committee members invite you to join them for the Xi State Legislative Symposium **February 6-7, 2018**: Tuesday, February 6 - Legislative Panel – 7:30 p.m. and Wednesday, February 7 – Morning Assembly – 7:00 a.m. followed by visit to legislators on Capitol Hill. Hotel reservations may be made at the Millennium Maxwell House in Nashville and are the responsibility of each attendee. The cost per room is \$115 per room + \$10 per person for hot breakfast buffet voucher in hotel dining room + tax. Walk-ins are welcome for the hotel breakfast buffet Wednesday morning from 6 a.m. – 7 a.m. for \$12/person. In order to book a room at the DKG group rate, we recommend that you make your reservation with the hotel by January 5 but no later than **January 15, 2018.**
